I've spent the weekend reading Mitchell Fink's marvelous new book called "The Last Days of Dead Celebrities," published by Hyperion/Miramax Books (ISBN# 1401351980.) This is a must-read: I am not kidding.

Fink — the former Daily News and People gossip columnist and CNN contributor — has done a remarkable job of interviewing all the people who knew and loved 15 famous people who have passed away, starting in 1980.

He begins with John Lennon and ends with John Ritter. None of it is sensational or tabloidy. All of it is so well-written, researched, thoughtfully told and as they say "fully authorized."

Another terrific chapter is devoted to **John Denver**, about whom I knew very little. Fink got everyone together who knew Denver in his last couple of years. He tries to dispel the idea that the singer's death in a small private plane was a suicide. But the feeling lingers that somehow Denver made a wrong turn in his life from which he thought he couldn't recover.

The portion of the book that talks about John Denver is from pages 166 to 186. It is very interesting since the author did a lot of research talking to people close to John, specifically those people who were with him in the last few days of his life. On September 6, 1997 John sent Annie some flowers for her 51st birthday. He always did this and 1997 was no exception. In September he also had concerts in San Antonio, Fort Worth, Houston, Austin and Corpus Christi where some lucky fans got to see him in concert for the last time.

Interesting to note is the fact that John spent October 6th with his son, Zachary, who flew in from Durango, Colorado. They attended a Denver Broncos football game together and met the players during half time. Then on October 7th John had his daughter, Anna Kate, over for dinner at his house. On October 10th John talked in detail to Milt Okun about a record deal that was of interest and he had an appointment to meet executives of the record company on the 13th of October. So his career was on the upswing again.

Several pages are devoted to John's last day where he lunched with friends and played golf. He had a lemonade/iced tea at lunch and apparently he had not been drinking for some time. When John died the media talked a lot about his DUI's as though there was some relationship between his former drinking problems and his untimely accident. But this was not the truth. The final report from the NTSB showed that there was no alcohol in his system at the time of his death.

What do John Denver, Evel Knievel, the Rolling Stones, Pizza Hut and EST have in common? Apparently, South Lake Tahoe City Councilman Ted Long.

Long is running for El Dorado County District 5 supervisor against incumbent Norma Santiago and has mailed about 6,000 copies of his 82-page autobiography "Recycled" to county residents in Tahoe.

The book details a recall election early in Long's political career and his relationship with EST, a company that gave controversial self-improvement seminars, where Long said he was once number two or three in the ranks.

It also mentions his company was the first to manage Knievel when the daredevil was just starting his career (page 26) and a friendship with singer and songwriter John Denver.

In the book Long said he was with Denver at his home in Woods Lake, Colorado, watching a meteor shower and drinking Peppermint Schnapps with hot chocolate when the musician got his inspiration for the song "Rocky Mountain High."

"The meteor shower was lavishly intense and went on for a long time. We took it in, awestruck, like a couple of kids at a Fourth of July fireworks display. At one point John said something about wanting to write a song about it."

The song's chorus line says "I've seen it raining fire in the sky."

"I asked him about it the next time I saw him, and he concurred that he had gleaned much of the inspiration for the song from that memorable night," Long wrote on page 42.

The two apparently met through EST.

It would be hard to miss these days the factoid that a record number 65 million votes were cast for Taylor Hicks to become the next American Idol. If you've seen Taylor Hicks perform, you know he's not your usual Idol. He's the ripe old age of 29, he has grey hair, and he sings soul. (Not to mention his unique dancing!) But, he won and he won big. Watching him progress through the show I took away three reasons why Taylor Hicks came out a winner and how you, I and everyone can be a winner, too, in pursuing our own dreams.

#### Reason #1: He Oozed Passion

Taylor was nothing if not enthusiastic! It oozed out of him. No matter what he sang you felt it — in his eyes, his smile, his body language, how he moved around the stage, everything! Believe me, I like him as a singer and I especially like that he sings soul and blues music so well. But, I LOVE his passion! That's what made me a Taylor fan.

I realized the impact of Taylor's enthusiasm on me one night while watching the show with a friend. Without prompting I blurted out "The thing about Taylor is that he's always entertaining. If he came out with a CD today, I'd buy it." I even surprised myself with these words. Then I knew why I felt that way. I simply wanted to soak in the incredibly positive feeling that Taylor was so willing to put out there for me to absorb.

#### Reason #2: He Stayed True to Himself

Another very endearing characteristic about Taylor that won people over is that he didn't stop being himself. And who he is turned out to be very appealing to a lot of people.

He didn't try to hide his age, even though at 29 he was the oldest person to make it to the American Idol finals. He didn't color his grey hair to look younger. He didn't move away from his preference to sing soul music, even though you can't find a soul tune in the today's Top 40. He didn't stop dancing, even though Simon often called it "hideous". Plus, he didn't minimize that he's from the deep South of Birmingham, Alabama, to avoid any negative, "ignorant" stereotype. For goodness sake, his last name is Hicks! Can you get more southern than that?!

Instead of avoiding anything, he stayed true to himself. His "Soul Patrol" legions of fans and others responded because he validated something about them personally. That's far from being ignorant; it's powerful.

#### Reason #3: His Practice Paid Off

Being a speaker and somewhat of a performer myself, I couldn't help but want to better understand how Taylor was able to let his passion ooze and be so comfortable with himself on stage. Then I learned that for years he had his own band in Birmingham where he performed over and over again. I began to put the pieces together. Taylor was able to easily let his passion and true self come through in front of millions of views on national TV each week because he had

been practicing for years on a smaller stage. I'm sure the first time he sang in front of a crowd he wasn't nearly as good as when he sang Elvis Presley's "In the Ghetto" in the last few final weeks of American Idol.

By singing over and over again he got better. Just like I've found being a speaker, it's in the doing that you improve. Simple and as hard as that. You don't get much glory practicing. True winners keep at it and hold onto to the dream that one day all their practicing will pay off and they will be ready to be on a larger stage. Oozing passion, being true to yourself, and practicing so you're really ready are three big reasons why Taylor Hicks won this year's American Idol. And they are the same reasons why you can be a winner in your own life, too. Here's to all of life's winners!

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"Peace ... The Message is Peace." That's what the producers of a pay-television seance to contact John Lennon claimed the former Beatle said when communicating with them from beyond the grave.

The show aired on Monday on pay-TV service In Demand and was organized by the producers of a failed 2003 attempt to channel the late Princess Diana's spirit, a show that earned scathing reviews but was estimated to have grossed close to \$8 million (4.5 million pounds).

People who paid \$9.95 to watch the pay-per-view Lennon special from 9 p.m. (2 a.m. British time) to 10:30 p.m. saw audio crew members, a psychic and an expert in paranormal activity claim that the late Beatle's spirit made contact with them through what is described as an Electronic Voice Phenomenon (EVP).

The EVP was discovered during a taping of a seance at La Fortuna restaurant in New York, which Lennon frequented.

The show's organizers said psychic Joe Power's voice feed went dead for a few seconds and the message was found on it when the tape of the voice feed was played back.

EVP is based on a belief that spirit voices communicate through radio and TV broadcast signals. On the television show, filming at La Fortuna suddenly stopped and a narrator said something odd has happened. Show participants said that a mysterious voice can be heard on Power's voice feed.

The producers called in "EVP specialist" Sandra Belanger to examine the voice and she proclaims it Lennon's.

Producer Paul Sharratt, who heads Starcast Productions and calls himself a skeptic, said hearing the voice has made him a believer.

The program was made without the knowledge or consent of Lennon's estate or his widow Yoko Ono, who declined comment. Ono's long-time friend and spokesman Elliot Mintz has called the entire exercise "tacky, exploitative and far removed" from Lennon's way of life. "A pay-per-view seance was never his style," said Mintz. Lennon was murdered by a deranged fan in New York 25 years ago.

His fans are known as the "soul patrol." But American Idol winner Taylor Hicks admits he has a soft spot for one certain country song. The silver-haired crooner says he started singing the old John Denver hit "Take Me Home, Country Roads" after the Sago Mine tragedy. Hicks says he was so touched by the story, that he started singing the song for the people of West Virginia and for all coal miners. Appearing on "Live With Regis and Kelly," Hicks says his great-grandfather was a coal miner in Alabama.

As a child I was lucky enough to have lots of music and singing, both at school and at home.

At university in the 6os I met traditional folk music for the first time and fell in love with its richness, subtle melodies and harmonies and its connections with the land and the seasons. My husband Rob and I met then, playing in a folk group together. From student days onwards I made attempts at writing songs, but it wasn't until our first child was born that I composed anything I felt I could share with others and that first song was written for our son. I still sing it. I had a deep longing to create songs that could speak to us now but still somehow incorporate a little of the magic and lovely familiarity that is so special in traditional music. Though I couldn't have articulated it at the time, my brief was to create songs that spoke to the heart, but hiddenly, awakening a dormant part of ourselves to meaning and joy.

That brief became conscious in me later on when I heard and read about the medieval troubadours of France, who were the news carriers, protest singers and disseminators of unorthodox views of their times, and dangerous times they were indeed. Their art had to be subtle and multi-layered to avoid political and religious censure. It was a question of 'he who has ears, let him hear'. That resonated so strongly with me. Leaving people free to hear or not is of the essence, so, for me, a song has to have more than one level.

I don't achieve that easily nor all the time by any means. When I was younger, songs and poems sometimes fell into my lap almost fully formed and that was very exciting, but now most of the time a lot of work has to go into fleshing out the original inspiration. The melodies also have branched out and taken on somewhat different styles, the French songs for instance having found their own distinctive flavor.

Fundamentally I have the sense that whatever we are told is happening 'out there', 'something else is going on!', (my very favorite expression), on deeper levels, that 'out there' doesn't know about. We can create a new reality, a reality constellated around the central axis of our being. In that place we 'know' the truth of our experience.

In my own small way I'd like my songs to foster that knowing, that trust in our own experience, and also the courage to explore further and deeper. To combine words from several of the lyrics: 'Don't let your heart stop at the surface. When you recognize your power to transform everything, you will know that you are the secret which the gods hold, and 'All the earth is listening for your heart's song.'

MOVE. It is, perhaps, the most magical word of all.

Simple, yet deep. Easy, yet arduous. Master the capacity to move and you've mastered life. Move and you'll be happy. Move and you'll be successful. Move and you'll be a genius.

Don't move and you won't. Movement's antonym — inertia — is a dream killer. A life killer. Literally. Sit around — don't move — and your body destroys itself. What doesn't kill us makes us stronger. What doesn't challenge and threaten us makes us weaker.

There's a lot of stuff that gets in the way of that simple goal, and I think that sometimes some straight talk is needed to awaken ourselves to remembering what we're here for. There is bad stuff out there in the world and it does no good to play ostrich and stick one's head in the sand. The bad stuff is there and having one's head in the sand exposes the rear end which may just get kicked, usually by surprise.

Albert Einstein is reputed to have said (although I cannot find a direct quote) that *today's problems will not be solved* by the same level of thinking that created them. I'm working to change the level of thinking by upping the ante by writing about various subjects in a way that will hopefully stir some folks to action. Every Modest Proposal will have a call to action. My job is to point out what I believe deserves action and to issue the call. My subscribers do what they're going to do (including nothing), and I honor them for that. My job is to create awareness and to inspire action not to judge what someone does or doesn't do.

The Way to Change the World...Uncommon thinking about common experiences, inspired by a quote attributed to Albert Einstein: "Today's problems cannot be solved at the same level of thinking that created them."

That's a pretty bold claim to make, and yet, why not? We're all equal in the eyes of the One; oh sure, different people have different skills, attributes, and life designs, but under the cover of skin, we are all equal. That's a lesson that I've only recently really gotten that just might be close to the level of wisdom.

Now about changing the world... I don't know about you, but I have shied away from even thinking about huge issues like the declining viability of our environment, the frustrating state of greedy governments, religions running rampant in the opposite direction from God, gross inequalities where billionaires co-inhabit cities with starving and diseased children, and on and on. These are such enormous problems that I've simply shrugged and said, "Heck, I'm only one person, and there's no way that I can make any impact, so here's a few bucks for a donation. Have a nice day."

Given enough people with that attitude (and I think there're a lot of us!), things tend to either stay the same or get worse – usually worse – so what can *just* one person, *any* person do? My reaction is to throw my hands up and say, "Let somebody else handle it – I've got my hands full with my own life." And y'know, that statement contains the roots of the answer: I do have my own life, so what am I going to do with it?

Let's look at the history of humanity, at least what the recorded distortions tell us. Permanent change (for the time that it's considered to be permanent) always comes about when it's from inside, either for an individual, a community, or a nation. Changes enforced from *outside* of the entity that is changed never last. Change which is not accepted by those being changed will simply be abandoned when the "foreign" agency attempting the change is no longer in control. On an individual basis look at the recidivism rate of people who are imprisoned... the vast majority of them return to crime after their release. The "correctional system" does not correct anything; most of the time it simply makes more effective criminals. The system presents no incentive to change so as soon as behavior is no longer controlled by the system, those who knuckle to it on the inside revert to their initial behavior because there is no internal drive to change.

Many historians of the US maintain that the establishment of organized crime in the US was enabled in 1920 by the 18th amendment to the constitution which prohibited the manufacture and sale of alcohol. The amendment was not supported by the majority of people. It was railroaded through the national and state legislatures by a small, powerful, minority special interest group who impressed their morality and beliefs on the entire population. Criminals organized to deliver alcohol to the majority of people, law enforcement (who wanted booze as well) looked the other way, and organized crime became a potent force in the US as it still is in one fashion or another today. [For you curious ones, the 18th amendment was reversed by the 21st amendment in 1933 having been law for only 13 years; we're still living with its aftermath today. Remember the *Godfather* and *The Sopranos*!]

The point has nothing to do with the morality of laws or belief systems. It has everything to do with the fact that permanent, effective change must take place internally within the entity for which the change is sought be that a person, community, nation, or planet. That brings us to, "I'm only one person so what can I do about these, huge global issues that nations, much less individuals, are not able to solve?"

It really comes down to us individually, and it always has. We just didn't realize it. There are two phenomena that serve to enable our ability to make a difference. The first one is by *example*, and the second one is *sharing*. "Example" is very powerful; in fact, most of what we learn is by the example that others set. Schools do their thing and have an important role in complex cultures, but in the matter of the business of living, example is how we learn. We watch mom and dad do whatever they do, and we start doing it the same way; perhaps not now, but eventually. Multiply that by all of the people that we observe and have contact with over the years and the behavior patterns get set. Dad throws fast food wrappers out of the window of the car, and a few years later, we are doing the same. Observation leads to learning which inevitably leads to behavior.

So where does that play on the world stage? If enough people in a community, state, or nation act on their own and independently to set an example, then others will emulate that behavior, and eventually when a critical mass is reached, the behavior (for example not throwing trash out of the car window) will become the norm and fewer people will do it. Laws don't work to bring about effective change if not embraced by the people to whom they are directed, and the law quickly becomes ineffective. How many people have you seen cited by the highway patrol for littering although all states and many countries have posted signs warning of the penalties for littering? I've driven over one million miles in the US and have yet to see or hear of anyone being cited for littering. Legislators pass laws and then pat themselves on the back (probably with another pay raise or other perk) and forget about the law as they toss wrappers out of their car windows.

Individuals aggregating into communities aggregating into nations aggregating into the whole world can bring about change because the people want the change and will embrace it whether governments want it or not. Remember prohibition! How then do we know what should be changed? That's a great question, and no doubt critics of this Modest Proposal will say something like "the will of the people is license for all manner of terrible things." Well, it's true that we deserve the consequences of our actions in all things. That's the defining nature of what it is to be spiritual, much less civilized, but there's a larger matter: namely doing what's right in our hearts and not what our heads (egos) tell us to do.

Western "civilization" is strongly characterized by a collective head trip by its collective citizenry. This head trip has led to Earth's northwest quadrant's monopolization of the world's resources and wealth. We rarely question how much is enough? When we do, the answer is generally, "We can never have too much! If those folks in the other latitudes have a tendency to suffer, well gosh, I'm sorry but I really don't care as long as I got mine, and well, if I don't, that's a great reason to start a war"... and you know how we love wars especially against a much weaker opponent

OK, such much for my ranting... how do we enable our hearts to shape our heads to choose the examples that we wish to set? It's not that tough... here are a few suggestions.

- 1. Think about something going on that you don't like.
- 2. Think about why you don't like it.
- 3. Think about where your dislike is rooted: is it about you personally or is it about what is fair and best for others?
- 4. If it's about more than yourself, there's a great possibility that you have a ripe opportunity for change.
- 5. When you have identified an opportunity, think about your willingness to change your actions with respect to it and resolve to do what you can. The more you do, the more powerful the example.

That brings us to the second part: sharing. How do we do that?

It's really simple: Do something! Rather than taking refuge in copping out by saying it's too big for you to make a difference, be in action. Everyone makes differences every day, either for positive or negative benefit. What do you choose? Sure, the differences are small. A sand storm is made up of small grains of sand. Tsunamis are made up of drops of water. It's in their union with others that makes them powerful forces. It really doesn't matter what you do in the matter of setting an example for the common good; it does matter that you do something. Let's take a look at things that *you* (no matter what your circumstances are) can do:

- 1. The very least that you can do is consciously infuse the energy of what you want changed with love. You don't even have to say it aloud; thinking it works too. "I love the idea that all children on the Earth are well nourished." *Everyone can do this.*
- 2. Along with consistently doing #1, find a well-intentioned and well-managed (there is a difference) organization that supports your desired change and make periodic contributions.

- 3. Along with consistently doing #1, do volunteer work for a well-intentioned and well-managed (there is a difference) organization that supports your desired change.
- 4. Along with consistently doing #1, write letters or emails to people of influence (elected officials, corporate executives, religious leaders, or anyone who can help) advocating their support of your desired change.
- 5. Along with consistently doing #1, talk to anyone who will listen about the need for your desired change and share with them how they can help.
- 6. Along with consistently doing #1, do whatever else you can think of that shares your desire for change with others locally, nationally, and internationally. The power of the Internet makes this far easier and faster than at any other time in the history of the world. There are news groups, blogs, websites, bulletin boards, and special interest groups that support *your* desire for change whatever it is; they are growing in numbers and participants daily. The users of the Internet and the number of websites are in the hundreds of millions and there is hardly a country that does not have Internet connectivity.

The aggregation of visible sharing is what can bring about a permanent change when it's supported somehow, some way by enough people. As the ancient wisdom tells us, "A journey of a thousand miles begins with a single step."

My Modest Proposal to you is: Take that first step towards creating your heartfelt, desired change. Each of the next steps gets easier. You've just got to get started - somewhere.
